



All Members will acknowledge agreement with the following Club Documents and Procedures.

Range Operations

1. Follow all safety Procedures when using any Range: Rifle, Pistol, Trap and Archery.
2. Range availability is at the discretion of the Club Safety Manager (CSM). No live firing will take place on any PR&GC range without an authorized PR&GC RSO (hereinafter referred to as an "RSO / In Charge", i.e., "RSO I/C") present and on duty.
3. Pay any range fee required before using any range. Trap Range fees may be paid upon signing out from that range.

Membership

1. Only the following persons are allowed to discharge guns or archery devices on the PR&GC Ranges: Club members and families (defined as spouses or domestic partners and/ or minor children of the Club member's family) as permitted by membership
3. All non-members must complete a One-Day Membership, which are for individuals, not for families. An NRA Membership is not required for One-Day Members.
4. Members must always be current in Club Membership and NRA Membership. ID Badge shows current dates.
5. Members must have a current ID Badge and have it always visible at the range.

Release from Liability

1. Members of any type and all guests shall read and sign the Release From Liability form, once each calendar year, prior to any live fire or any other use of the range

Alcoholic Beverages and Drugs

Members and guests may not consume alcoholic beverages or drugs before or during live fire. Alcohol is prohibited on the range property.

Violation of Club Rules

Any member who violates Safety Rules, Club Bylaws or Range Operations may be subject to disciplinary action.
